Achim Bender joined the firm of VOSSIUS & PARTNER as an Attorney-at-Law in October 2013. He specializes in European Trade Mark Law. He was Presiding Judge of a Trade Mark Senate at the German Federal Patent Court in Munich from 2008 to 2013 and Member of the Boards of Appeal of the Office for Harmonization in the Internal Market (OHIM) in Alicante from 1997 to 2007. From 1995 to 1997, he worked as a scientific assistant with the Patent Senate of the German Federal Supreme Court in Karlsruhe. Since 1991 he has been working as a Judge at the German Federal Patent Court, and previously, since 1976, in various positions including as State Prosecutor and Judge at the Bavarian Courts, inter alia at the Munich Regional Court II as Vice Chairman of one of the Chambers of Commerce.

Achim is a lecturer at the University of Düsseldorf and at several universities throughout Germany and in other countries. Furthermore, he regularly teaches at Intellectual Property conferences and supervises qualification and formation of lawyers and patent attorneys.

In addition to numerous publications in legal journals, Achim is co-author of the “Manual of Trade Mark Practice” (CH Beck, Munich, 2nd edition, 2012), the “Practice Handbook of Intellectual Property and Competition Law” (Nomos, Baden-Baden, 2011), co-editor and co-author of the liber amicorum “50 years of Federal Patent Court” (CH Beck, Munich, 2011), the “Heidelberg Commentary on Trade Mark Law” (CF Müller, Heidelberg, 2003), author of “European Trade Mark, an introduction into the Community Trade Mark System” (Carl Heymanns, Cologne, 2008) and co-author of “PAVIS PROMA Trade Mark Decisions FPC, OHIM, FCJ, EGC, ECJ” (continuously updated since 1999). He is a member of the Committee of Experts on Competition and Trademark Law of GRUR (German Association for the Protection of Intellectual Property).
