



ANTÓNIO CAMPINOS, OHIM President, ES

António Campinos became President of OHIM on 1 October 2010. Mr Campinos is 45 years old, and a native of Portugal. After studying law at the Universities of Montpellier and Nancy, he worked in banking before moving to the public sector. Mr Campinos became IP Commissioner and President of the Directive Council of the National Institute of Industrial Property (INPI) of Portugal in 2005. Mr Campinos was also Chairman of the Ad Hoc working group on the Legal Development of the Madrid System for the International Registration of Marks. Mr Campinos has had strong links with OHIM for many years. From November 2005 to November 2007, he was head of the Portuguese delegation to OHIM's governing body, its Administrative Board, and became its Chairman in November 2007, prior to his election as President.
